

## **AYLSHAM AGRICULTURAL SHOW ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP**

1. The Members will receive two badges, each of which will admit one person to the Show ground and Member's Enclosure.
2. Members may also obtain Members Enclosure tickets for their friends price £8.00 each, children under 16 free of charge if accompanied by an adult. Tickets available from the Secretary in advance or on the Showground at the Members' Enclosure Gate. This does not entitle admission onto the Showground.
3. There will be a licence bar and catering facilities, including luncheons and teas, in the Members Enclosure for members and their guests.
4. The Committee invites all competitors and those interested in the Show to become members of the Association.
5. Annual Subscription is £30.00 (£35 paid after 31<sup>st</sup> July) payable to the Secretary. Entitlements are for two people or £15 single membership if aged under 26.

### **EXHIBITORS AND COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE**

1. Numbers will be posted to Competitors except in the case of Show Jumping and late entries.
2. Any Exhibitor, Competitor or Member without the correct pass will be charged the normal admission fee. Adults £10.00. Accompanied Children under 16 and Car Parking Free of Charge.
3. Each Competitor/Exhibitor will receive 1 vehicle pass and 1 admission ticket for the show ground. Additional passengers will be charged at the gate.

### **SHOW REGULATIONS**

1. The decision of the Judges is final.
2. Only officials will be permitted to enter the Ring.
3. The Committee reserves the absolute right to refuse any entry without stating the reason for doing so.
4. The Committee reserves the absolute right to alter the time and/or sequence of events at their discretion.
5. The Organiser of this Show has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
6. No claim can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants, livestock, in connection with or arising out of this Show. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from such accident.
7. Objections must be made to the Secretary's Marquee in writing within 15 minutes of incident, and accompanied by a deposit of £30, returnable if objection is sustained.
8. Prizes may be limited in any Class according to entries. The right to amalgamate classes if insufficient entries is also reserved.
9. All cups and trophies are perpetual and must be returned, in could order, to the Show Office prior to the following year's Aylsham Show
10. No animal will be allowed to leave the Showground until after the Grand Parade. All Champion, Reserve Champion, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize winners will be expected to parade in the Main Ring at the required time.

# **SHEEP**

1. Covered penning and straw will be provided.
2. The Show will be licensed by the Norfolk County Council under Article 16 (3) of the Sheep Scab Order 1977.
3. Entries from MAEDI/VISNA (MV) accredited flocks will be penned in separate shedding in accordance with the information declared on the entry form by the Exhibitor. A pre-entry permit is required, obtainable from SAC, PO Box 604, Milton Keynes. The Association cannot accept responsibility for any exhibitor who loses his health status when attending the Show.
4. Every sheep shall be entered, or eligible for entry, in the Pedigree Flock Book of its Breed in this Country. Proof of entry to be furnished to the Secretary if so required.
5. All sheep shall be marked for identification and/or shown in accordance with the rules of their respective Breed Society.
6. The Head Steward will be entitled to have all or any of the entries examined by the Association's Honorary Veterinary Surgeon before unloading.
7. Classes will be amalgamated if there are insufficient entries (less than 4 exhibitors).
8. The Head Steward may alter times of Classes should the need arise.
9. **Late Entries:** No late entries will be accepted at the Show Office after the 18<sup>th</sup> August. **Please Note: THERE WILL BE NO LATE ENTRIES ON THE DAY.**
