AYLSHAM AGRICULTURAL SHOW ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP

1. The Members will receive two badges, each of which will admit one person to the Show ground and Member's Enclosure.
2. Members may also obtain Members Enclosure tickets for their friends price £8.00 each, children under 16 free of charge if accompanied by an adult. Tickets available from the Secretary in advance or on the Showground at the Members' Enclosure Gate. This does not entitle admission onto the Showground.
3. There will be a licence bar and catering facilities, including luncheons and teas, in the Members Enclosure for members and their guests.
4. The Committee invites all competitors and those interested in the Show to become members of the Association.
5. Annual Subscription is £30.00 (£35 paid after 31st July) payable to the Secretary. Entitlements are for two people or £15 single membership if aged under 26.

EXHIBITORS AND COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE

1. Numbers will be posted to Competitors except in the case of Show Jumping and late entries.
2. Any Exhibitor, Competitor or Member without the correct pass will be charged the normal admission fee. Adults £10.00. Accompanied Children under 16 and Car Parking Free of Charge.
3. Each Competitor/Exhibitor will receive 1 vehicle pass and 1 admission ticket for the show ground. Additional passengers will be charged at the gate.

SHOW REGULATIONS

1. The decision of the Judges is final.
2. Only officials will be permitted to enter the Ring.
3. The Committee reserves the absolute right to refuse any entry without stating the reason for doing so.
4. The Committee reserves the absolute right to alter the time and/or sequence of events at their discretion.
5. The Organiser of this Show has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
6. No claim can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants, livestock, in connection with or arising out of this Show. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from such accident.
7. Objections must be made to the Secretary's Marquee in writing within 15 minutes of incident, and accompanied by a deposit of £30, returnable if objection is sustained.
8. Prizes may be limited in any Class according to entries. The right to amalgamate classes if insufficient entries is also reserved.
9. All cups and trophies are perpetual and must be returned, in could order, to the Show Office prior to the following year's Aylsham Show
10. No animal will be allowed to leave the Showground until after the Grand Parade. All Champion, Reserve Champion, 1st, 2nd and 3rd Prize winners will be expected to parade in the Main Ring at the required time.

HORSE REGULATIONS

1. **Entries** will not be accepted without the appropriate fee and correct membership information. Entry fees are NOT refundable except in BSJA Classes under Rule 79(3). All telephone cancellations must be confirmed in writing.
2. Entries may be limited in each class. Substitution or Nomination entries will not be accepted except Substitutions will be allowed in accordance with B.S.J.A Rule 79(3). Prizes may be limited under B.S.J.A. Rule 76(6).
3. Entries close by the 15th August 2009. **Late entries** in Showing will be accepted where space permits in all classes but will be **£3 extra**. **Late Entry** for show jumping will be **£1 extra**. Late entries after the closing date must be made on the day and will be taken by the Late Entry Steward located near the Horse Rings. No late Entry fee will be charged for Fun Classes 76 – 79 in Ring 7. Persons without passes will be charged at the entrance gate and only Competitors will have the entry fee refunded.
4. **NO CARS will be permitted in the Horse Box park unless displaying a Red Car Pass. A Car Pass may be obtained from the Aylsham Show Office up to and including Saturday 29th August.**
5. Owners enter their horses at their own risk, and it is a condition of every entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the B.S.J.A., Ponies (UK), or the Show Organisers.
6. All B.S.J.A. Jumping Competitions will be limited to 60 starters.
7. Any Exhibitor bringing an animal onto the show ground labouring under an infectious or contagious disease shall be liable to a fine of £25.00
8. Control & Conduct: Any animal not under control or in any way constituting a danger shall be removed from the show ring at the request of the Judge, Steward or Secretary. Anyone causing a disturbance or any bad behaviour throughout the show are liable to be disqualified from competing in the show. **All competitors are reminded that verbal attacks on Judges, Stewards or other volunteers will not be tolerated and will result in disqualification.**
9. The Judge's decision is final. Objections must be lodged, together with the sum of £30. (£100 for BSJA) on the day of the competition, at the Secretary's Office. All timings are approximate and subject to change.
10. The Show Committee reserve the right to curtail the number of prizes awarded in any class at their discretion.
11. A skull cap or a hat and safety harness according to EN1384, ASTM F 1163 or PAS015 or higher must be worn by ALL competitors in any jumping phases. Skullcaps must have a black or navy cover. The Organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone present must themselves take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. Instructions given by any officials must be obeyed.
12. Any juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before 1st Jan 2009 may not lead Stallions/Colts. All rules appertaining to Stallions are as per the Ponies (UK) Rule Book 2009
13. Judges may require horses or ponies to be measured.
14. Evidence of age may be asked for in Children's Classes.
15. There is a charge of £2 per rider to cover the costs of First Aid Cover.
