CATTLE CLASSES

1. All Cattle exhibited at the Show must be from Herds entered in the register of Attested Herds at the date of the Show.
2. Exhibitors whose herd's attested status is withdrawn after the date of entry may reclaim their entry fees.
3. All Cattle must be from accredited Herds. No responsibility can be accepted if health status is lost by non-compliance with this ruling. Confirmation of health status of all animals must be shown on entry form.
4. Cattle, without prior permission, will not be permitted onto the show ground before the Show day.
5. **Late entries.** No late entries will be accepted at the Show Office after 13th August. All additional late entries must be made on the day and to be made to the Late Entry Steward who will be situated near the Cattle Lines.
6. **Please note.** All exhibitors are asked to collect their exhibitor numbers from the Cattle Stewards' Marquee on Show Day.
7. No cattle will not be able to leave the showground until after 4.0.0. p.m.
